Biographical Sketch: Dr. Peter Woroby was born in Starhorod, Ukraine and attended universities in Berlin and in Goettingen obtaining a Ph.D. in economics. He married Nadia Cherniak before immigrating to Canada taking a position at the University of Manitoba in 1949 and in 1952 becoming Director of Economic Research for the Saskatchewan Power Corporation. Woroby was interested in the area of resource economics; those involving energy, water and agriculture, he was also interested in studying urban research and in 1965 Woroby began teaching at the University of Saskatchewan, Regina Campus as a Professor in the Department of Economics specializing in Urban Economics.

Woroby wrote numerous scholarly publications and was a contributor to two royal commissions, he was a founding member of the Ukrainian Canadian Professional and Business Club, Regina Chapter, and served at the executive and national levels of the Ukrainian Canadian Committee from Regina.

Woroby was appointed special advisor to the government of Saskatchewan on Ukraine from 1990 to 1995, and traveled to Ukraine frequently to lecture on economic reform or to consult with government or with academic institutions. Woroby is also credited with initiating significant opportunities for Canada and the Ukraine to work together on various projects.

At the University of Regina the Dr. Peter Woroby Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a student who is registered in a Bachelor of Arts or Bachelor of Science degree majoring in Economics with a combined/double major in Economics.

Woroby became Professor Emeritus in 1987 and passed away in May, 2002.
