BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Edwin (Ed) Orrin Gould was born in Turner Valley, Alberta on February 26, 1936. He was educated at the University of British Columbia and University of Victoria. Gould began writing as a reporter and editor for various newspapers, the Canadian Press and the CBC before establishing himself as a freelance writer. He also worked as a freelance broadcaster and publisher and co-founded his own publishing company in the 1980s, Cappis Press. Gould's writing has appeared in numerous periodicals and newspapers and in 1973 he was awarded the Media Club of Canada award. Gould has written book reviews, pieces of fiction and humour, and articles that reflect his interest in travel, film, the arts and Canadian personalities, between 1975 and 1988, twelve books written by him were published, many of which focus specifically on Canadian subjects. The biography, "Ralph Edwards of Lonesome Lake" (1979) and "Logging: British Columbia Logging History" (1975) are among his best known publications. A permanent injunction was granted in 1985 for his book called "Ranching: Ranching in Western Canada" (Hancock, 1978), Gould was charged with plagiarizing a doctoral thesis entitled "The Canadian West and Ranching Frontier, 1875-1922" and sales of the book were then restricted. Edwin Orrin Gould died in Vancouver General Hospital on April 13, 2001.
