INTRODUCTION

Note on Arrangement: Geoffrey Ursell's original arrangement was adhered to as closely as possible, following the wishes of the donor.

Geoffrey Ursell was born in Moose Jaw in 1943. He obtained a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) and Masters of Arts from the University of Manitoba in 1965 and 1966 respectively. His Ph. D. was earned from the University of London in 1973. He returned to the University of Manitoba as a Lecturer in English from 1971 to 1973. From there he went to the University of Regina as a Special Lecturer in English from 1975 - 1978 and Assistant Professor in 1980-81 and 1982-83.

Geoffrey is a writer, composer, poet, and editor. He has earned many awards: Clifford E. Lee Playwriting Award, Edmonton Critics' First Night Award, Performing Arts in Canada One-Act Play Competition, Persephone Theatre National Playwriting Competition Award, and Books in Canada First Novel Award, plus grants from Canada Council, Saskatchewan Arts Board, Ontario Arts Council, and many others.

His professional activities are numerous: President, Thunder Creek Publishing Co.; Writer-in-Residence, Saskatoon Public Library and Winnipeg Public Library; Associate Director, 25th Street Theatre; member-atlarge, Writer Director, and Vice-President, ACTRA; President, Saskatchewan Writers' Guild; and Member, Saskatchewan Sport Trust Cultural Steering Committee.

He has had several articles published in various publications i.e. Grain, NeWest Review, Quarry, Western People, Canadian Fiction Magazine, and This Magazine.

This collection contains information on his education and teaching careers. His business records as writer, composer, poet and editor from 1969 to 1987 are also enclosed along with his involvement with various professional associations from 1976 to 1988. The latter portion comprises approximately 40% of the collection. The remainder consists of his writing career in his novels, plays, poetry, and publishing. 3 record album covers (two include records) and a small section of writings by others, including articles about him, is also included. Writing Workshops and Projects completes the materials.
