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## **BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE**

Lorna Crozier was born in Swift Current in 1948. She attended the University of Regina, as well as the University of Saskatchewan and Alberta, where she received an M.A. in 1980. After spending several years teaching high school English, Crozier had established herself as a poet well enough to quit her job and devote herself full time to poetry. Over the years she has published numerous books of poetry, edited an anthology of Saskatchewan poetry, published poems in over eleven anthologies, and has had literally dozens and dozens of her poems published in such journals as <a href="Border Crossings">Border Crossings</a>, <a href="Poetry Canada Review">Poetry Canada Review</a>, <a href="Fireweed">Fireweed</a>, <a href="NeWest Review">NeWest Review</a>, <a href="Descant">Descant</a>, <a href="Canadian Literature">Canadian Literature</a>, <a href="Grain">Grain</a> and so on. Currently, she lives in Victoria with her husband, poet Patrick Lane, and teaches in the Creative Writing Department of the University of Victoria.

This is the third collection of papers from Crozier. They are from two very different periods of time in Crozier's life and career. The first set is from her early period of education and writing, from 1971 to 1979. We get a sense of Crozier's interests and the possible influences of her post-secondary education on her early attitudes. We also see the passing of a seminal period in Crozier's life, when she went from teaching high school to begin her life's work writing poetry, and when she met and joined up with Patrick Lane. Many of the persons whom Crozier corresponds with in this early period are those who show up in the later period as well, even though her life substantially changed in its other aspects.

The second set of papers, which dates from 1980 to 1992, with the majority of the documents dating from 1990 and 1991, sees a curious return to full-time teaching for Crozier, this time as a university professor. The range of different professional activities Crozier is engaged in is astounding; from readings to touring, from editing to jurying, and from writing politician's speeches to leading seminars and summer classes. We can see the professional development which has taken place between when she was starting out and her current career. There is a very neat contrast between the two periods, making this an exceptional collection to study.

# Note on Arrangement:

Where original order existed, it was maintained as closely as possible. Original file titles provided by Crozier which are unusual were retained and placed in quotation marks to distinguish them from titles generated by the archivist.

There is some overlap between the correspondence in the early period with the correspondence in the later period. The split has been maintained to be true to the original order and to provide the flavour and content of Crozier's early education and writing career.

There are CLOSED files within this collection.
