Biographical Sketch

Tony Tascona was born in Saint Boniface, Manitoba on March 16, 1926. He is currently married to Doreen Millin. Their present residence is in Winnipeg, Manitoba.

Education: In 1950 he attended the Winnipeg School of Art and received a Diploma in Art. At the University of Manitoba, School of Fine Arts from 1950 to 1952 he took Postgraduate Studies.

Occupation, life and activities: Tony is a well-known Canadian sculptor, print-maker and painter.

Tony has served as juror on several occasions on Canada Council/Parks Canada Sculpture Competition for the Forks in Winnipeg in 1987; Manitoba Arts Council in 1984; Canada Council Art for Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba for 1983; Manitoba Arts Council 1979 to 1980; "Red River Exhibition", Moorhead State University in 1978 and Manitoba Government Services 1% Minister's Committee 1975 to 1979.

He has conducted lectures and workshops across western Canada and North Dakota. "Seeing It Our Way", a video/slide presentation was used as a CBC documentary in 1984. TV Ontario presented "Visions: a Definition of Space - Prairie Visual Artists: Dorothy Knowles, Don Proch and Tony Tascona" (a video/slide collection).
