KIEU MA, MICHELLE OLSON AND ELIZABETH SEITZ **ADMINSTRATIVE SKETCH:** Coteau Books was established in 1975 as the book division of the Thunder Creek Publishing Co-operative. Thunder Creek was set up as a non-profit publishing co-operative whose key goal was to publish prairie and Canadian writing - poetry, fiction, songs, plays, and children's books. The name Coteau is taken from the Missouri Coteau, a range of hills which exist west of Moose Jaw.

Originally based in Moose Jaw, Coteau's four original board members, Barbara Sapergia, Geoffrey Ursell, Robert Currie, and Gary Hyland, were responsible for editing and production, with the assistance of one person hired to handle orders. By 1983 Coteau had established a branch office in Regina with a managing editor and two additional employees. The four original board members were eventually joined by seven others in 1978 and 1983. In 1988, Gary Hyland quit the Co-operative to concentrate on his own writing. The Board of Directors still contains three of the original members of the Thunder Creek Publishing Co-operative: Sapergia, Ursell, and Currie. Other members of the Board have changed since 1983, and appointment policy remains informal, with some members choosing to take leaves of absence, and others resigning after varying periods of time. Executive Board positions change every year.

These papers were generated and collected by Coteau Books and include files pertaining to publishers and professional and governmental organizations which maintained a relationship with Coteau. The papers also reflect the growth of Coteau Books from an arm of a small co-operative run by its members to an established publisher with three employees. Of special note is the large quantity of manuscripts in various stages of production.

This collection encompasses the years 1975 to 1996 and measures approximately 11 metres, it includes photographs and negatives, oversize posters, slides, contact sheets, one artifact, colour separations and computer disks (both 5 1/4 and 3 1/4 in size), the 3 1/4 disks were copied to the University's server for interim preservation in February 2019 when Archives staff also located thermal fax paper within the collection and other material which was photocopied for preservation purposes.

Scope and content: Fonds consists of records related to the publishing of books and play scripts and the production of record albums.


