Oversize Portfolio No. 1

- 1947 – Proposal for a mural in the Plaza Hotel restaurant and bar, Sparks Street, Ottawa.
 - Includes two drawings (paintings)
 - Not executed
- 1954 – Proposal for a mural in the lobby of the new Post Office, Regina, Saskatchewan.
 - Includes a sketch “From Sea to Sea”
 - Not executed
- 1955 – Proposal for a mural in the living room of Mrs. Gibbs of Regina, Saskatchewan.
 - Includes one sketch
 - Not executed
- 1956 – Proposal for a mural for the Regina Branch of the Canadian Legion
 - Includes eight mural sketches in pencil
 - See brochure and opening ceremony programme
 - (There is an actual model 1”=1’ of the chamber with watercolour rendering. Whereabouts unknown. The Legion may have it).

Oversize Portfolio No. 2

- 1957-8 – Proposal for a mural for the Airport Terminal, Gander, Newfoundland.
 - Commissioned by the Department of Transport, Canada.
 - Includes – Illustrated reproductions of scale cartoon with descriptive text
 - Black and white photographs of mural, 11 3/4” x 15 1/2”
 - Preliminary sketches:

- Includes – Plan sketch
 - 3 rough sketches
 - 1 watercolour and felt pen large sketch presentation
- 1968 – Proposal for a banner for Winters College, to hang in the main dining room, York University, Toronto
- Includes – 1 working drawing
 - 10 watercolour and designers paper collage works on paper
 - 2 pencil and felt pen drawings
 - Note: The banner was designed by Kenneth Lochhead and made by Patricia Lochhead.
- 1968 – Proposal for a banner commission for the Confederation Art Gallery, Prince Edward Island

Oversize Portfolio No.5

- 1969–70 – Proposal for a decorative work to be attached to an existing wooden wall located behind the receptionist desk in the official entrance foyer of the Canadian Chancery Building, Warsaw, Poland.
- Includes – 5 watercolour and felt pen sketches
 - 17 tracing tissue sketches in felt pen
 - architect's working drawings of foyer, etc.

Oversize Portfolio No. 6

- 1970 – Proposal for a neon-light art work for the Centennial Concert Hall, Winnipeg, Manitoba
- Includes – Working plan for installation (1 original, 1 copy)
 - 2 large matted coloured drawings in watercolour and felt pen
 - 4 small sketches in felt pen
 - 24 felt pen sketches with watercolour
 - Not executed

Oversize Portfolio No. 7

- 1970 – Proposal for mural for main banking area, Bank of Montreal, Mountain and McGregor branch, Winnipeg, Manitoba
- Includes – Working drawing plan
 - Final presentation sketch
 - 7 colour sketches in watercolour

- 1981 – A preliminary proposal for a fountain at the entrance to Rideau Hall, Ottawa.
- Includes – 4 photographs of the site
 - 2 presentation watercolours
 - Not submitted or executed
- 1988-89 – Mural for Minto Place Suite Hotel, Laurier Avenue, Ottawa
- Includes – Final sketch used by artist, for commissioned work “Forest Fête
 - Note: 2 framed sketches, watercolour on paper, 11” x 32” (approx.) and 2 framed paintings, actual-sized details, oil on canvas, 30” x 30” are included. One sketch and painting is of “Forest Fête” and the other set is “Bouquet Garden”, an alternate proposal which was not selected.

Oversize Portfolio No. 8 (Additional bits and pieces)

- 1954 – Proposal for a mural in the lobby of the new Post Office, Regina, Saskatchewan
- Includes one large detailed sketch “From Sea to Sea”
 - Not executed
- 1957–58 – Preparatory sketches for the Gander Airport Mural, Gander, Newfoundland.
- Includes – 14 sketches in a variety of mediums (pencil, watercolour, pastel), 18 ½” x 25”.
- 1969 – Proposals for long, narrow paintings. Not for any particular venue.
- Includes – 1 folder, 20” x 26” with 5 designs in cut coloured paper
 - 8 pieces of cut coloured paper on cardboard, sizes ranging from 1 ½” x 14 ½” to 3 1/8” x 26”
- 1972 – Preliminary sketches for “External Affairs”, the mural for the Passport Office in the Department of External Affairs, Ottawa.
- Includes – 3 felt pen sketches
 - 7 sketches on light paper
- 1976 – Poster for the 1976 Canada Olympics
- The Artists–Athletes Coalition for the Celebration of the 1976 Olympics put out an open call to artists for design proposals for the Olympic posters. Ten artists were selected.
- 1994 – Proposal for the Dovercourt Community Centre and McKeller Park wading pools
- Includes – 1 collage in coloured paper 19 ½” x 25 ½”, mounted under plastic for reference while working outside.
 - Preliminary sketch only.
