Scope and Content:

The majority of this collection consists of research notes and information for his interviews, documentaries, stories, etc., e.g. the illegal export of artillery shells from Canada into South Africa, or the Canadair Challenger scandal.

This collection consists of 5.53 m of material, 24 photographs, 10 artifacts, and 105 oversize items, 2 cassette tapes, 2 video tapes (one is missing).

The original filing system as established by Eric Malling has been maintained.

Biographical Sketch:

Eric Malling was born in Swift Current, Saskatchewan, on September 4, 1946, and died of a cerebral hemorrhage in Toronto on September 28, 1998. He attended the University of Saskatchewan, receiving his Bachelor of Arts in English Literature, and went on to Carleton University School of Journalism. After graduation, he worked for the *Swift Current Sun* and the *Regina Leader-Post*. In 1968, he began work for the *Toronto Star*. In 1974, he did interviews on *Canada AM* on CTV. He joined *the Fifth Estate* on CBC in 1976, hosting it for 14 years. He then went to *W5* at CTV in 1990. This program was renamed *W5 With Eric Malling*. Malling won one Gemini Award and six ACTRA awards. He is the only person to have won the Gordon Sinclair Award for excellence in broadcast journalism three times.
