THE SURVEY

- Survey designed & conducted by Academica
- Survey sponsor (U of R) not revealed to avoid bias
- High School Guidance/Career Counsellors in SK, southern AB and south-western MB
- Topics
 - > Perceptions of selected universities in prairie region
 - ➤ Sources of information in counselling students re PSE
 - ➤ Participation in *Maclean's* ranking survey and use of the rankings



THE SURVEY

- Conducted Feb 15/17 to Mar 26/17
- •Response rates ranged from 27% for Saskatchewan (n=65) to 22% in each of the other provinces (combined n=60)
- The majority of respondents see themselves as career counsellors (not guidance)



THE KEY FINDINGS

- •The *Maclean's* rankings have little to no influence on the student advising activities.
- •Very few counsellors participate in the *Maclean's* reputational survey.
- Many are not aware of its existence and are not aware of an invitation to participate.
- •Others feel they don't know enough about the universities.
- •61 of the 125 respondents believe that the U of R is ranked too low in the *Maclean's* reputational survey ("Best Overall" measure).



The *Maclean's* rankings were not seen to be an important source of information.

Counsellors discuss the *Maclean's* rankings very infrequently with their students

Very few of the counsellors have participated in *Maclean's* survey of guidance counsellors.

Q17. Have you participated in the Maclean's University Ranking survey that targets guidance counsellors?

The main reasons for not participating among those who knew of the survey

- Was not invited to complete the survey
- Don't know enough about the universities.
- •20% don't believe in ranking universities.

Q18. For the National Reputational Ranking component of its University Rankings publication, Maclean's gathers the views of survey respondents on the quality of 49 Canadian universities. The table below shows results of the "Best Overall" national ranking for a number of universities as published in November 2016.

Manitoba Sample (n=13)	Too high	Too low	About right	Don't know
University of Manitoba: 14	8%	-	54%	38%
University of Saskatchewan: 22	-	23%	8%	69%
University of Regina: 34	-	8%	15%	77%
University of Winnipeg: 38		23%	8%	68%
Brandon University: 48	+	46%	31%	23%



Conclusions

- Maclean's rankings have little to no influence on counsellors' advice to students.
- •Regarding the counsellors' survey, *Maclean's* reputational rankings have little validity.
- •Counsellors are looking for information regarding attributes they value:
- >the quality of instructors
- >employment success of graduates
- >student support services, and
- ➤ the presence of an inspirational learning environment.
