

## CUSC 2021 - Graduating Student Survey

### CUSC Background

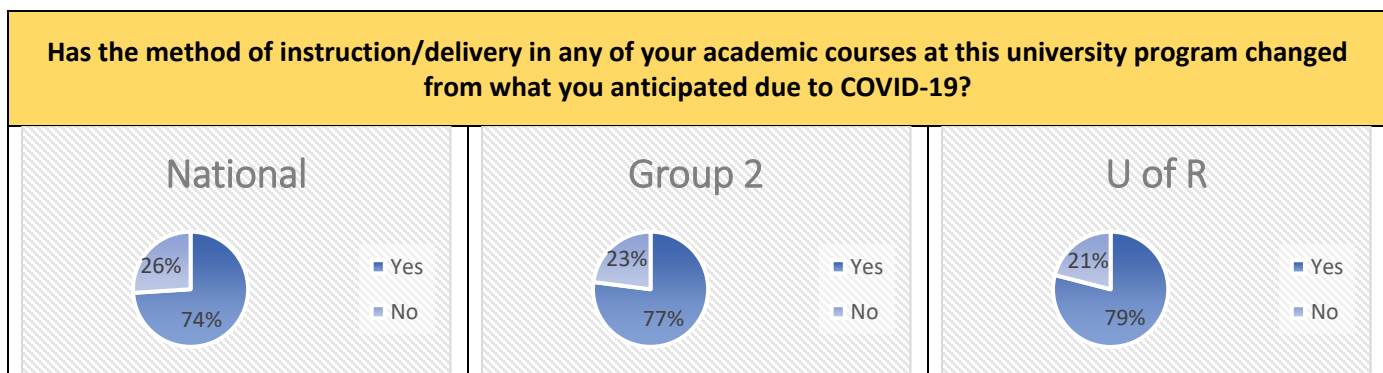
The 2021 *Graduating Student Survey* marks the 27th cooperative study undertaken by the *Canadian University Survey Consortium / Consortium canadien de recherche sur les étudiants universitaires (CUSC/CCREU)* and the 22<sup>nd</sup> study in which the University of Regina has participated. The 2021 survey involved 32 universities and over 15,000 graduating university students from across Canada. Graduating students are those who are deemed eligible to graduate in 2021.

A set of questions about the impact of the **COVID-19** pandemic were added to the 2021 survey. Participation was optional for institutions. The results shown in this report are only from graduating students at participating institutions.

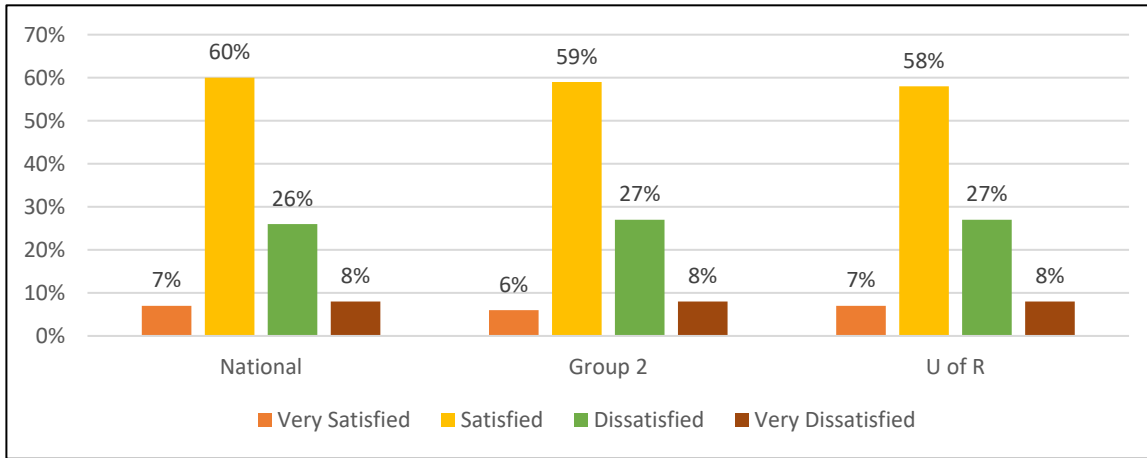
### Methods of instruction/delivery

Since September 2020, which of the following methods of instruction/delivery have you used to take academic courses from this university?	National (n=12,916)	Group 2 (n=3,822)	U of R (n=445)
Online with live/synchronous instruction (e.g., real-time audio or video)	90%	92%	89%
Online without live/asynchronous instruction (e.g., learning modules, recorded lectures)	84%	85%	68%
In a seminar room, classroom or lecture hall	16%	16%	17%
In a lab or studio	12%	12%	16%
Other	3%	3%	7%

Note: Respondents could provide more than one answer.



**How satisfied are you with how your university has adapted the instructional component of your courses?**

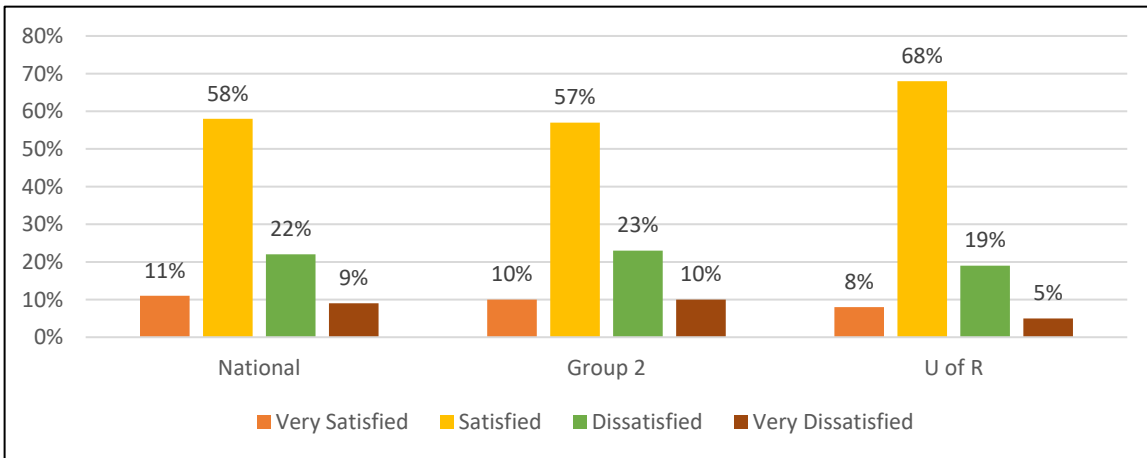

Enrolled in external experiential learning, with changes	12%	14%	28%
Enrolled in external experiential learning, no changes	6%	6%	17%
Not enrolled	81%	80%	56%

**How satisfied are you with how your university has adapted the external experiential learning component of your courses?**

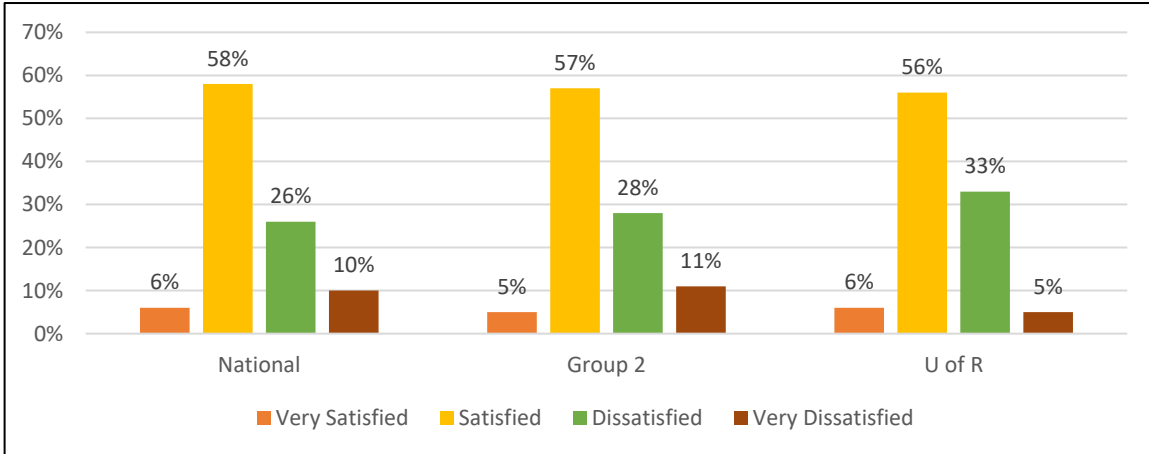

Enrolled in internal experiential learning, with changes	28%	31%	24%
Enrolled in internal experiential learning, no changes	10%	10%	8%
Not enrolled	62%	59%	68%

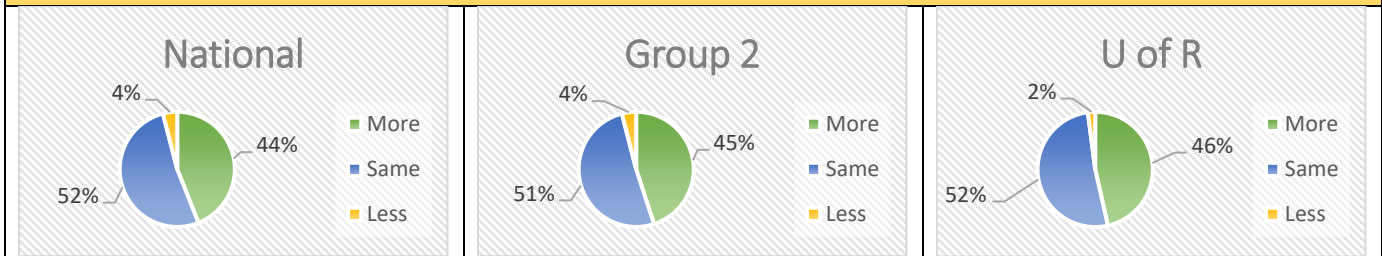
### How satisfied are you with how your university has adapted the internal experiential learning component of your courses?

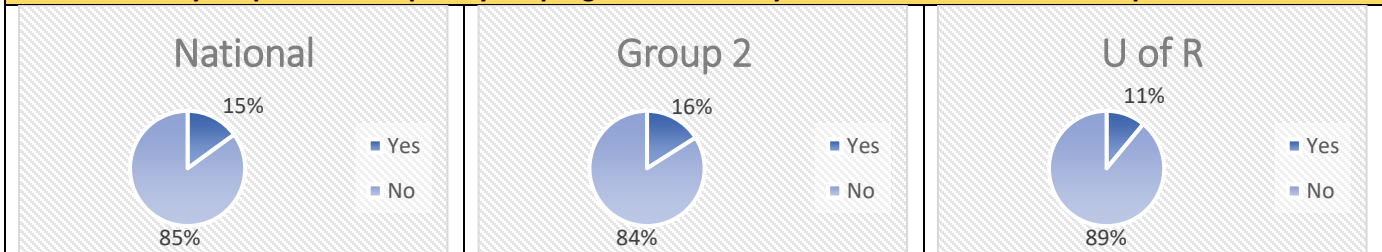
## Ability to Access Services

### Generally speaking, since the COVID-19 pandemic began, would you say that being able to access the services you used at your university is more or less difficult?



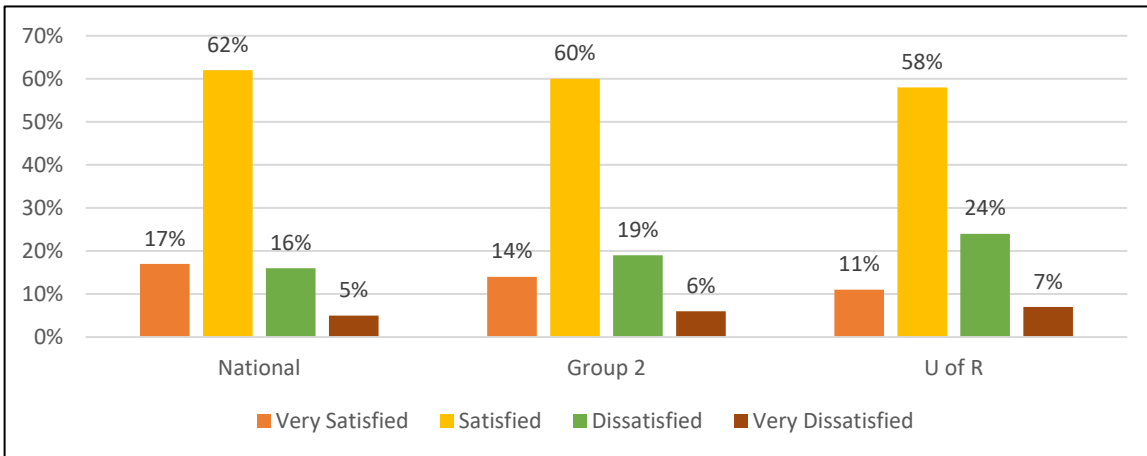
## Delays from COVID-19

### Have your plans to complete your program been delayed because of the COVID-19 pandemic?

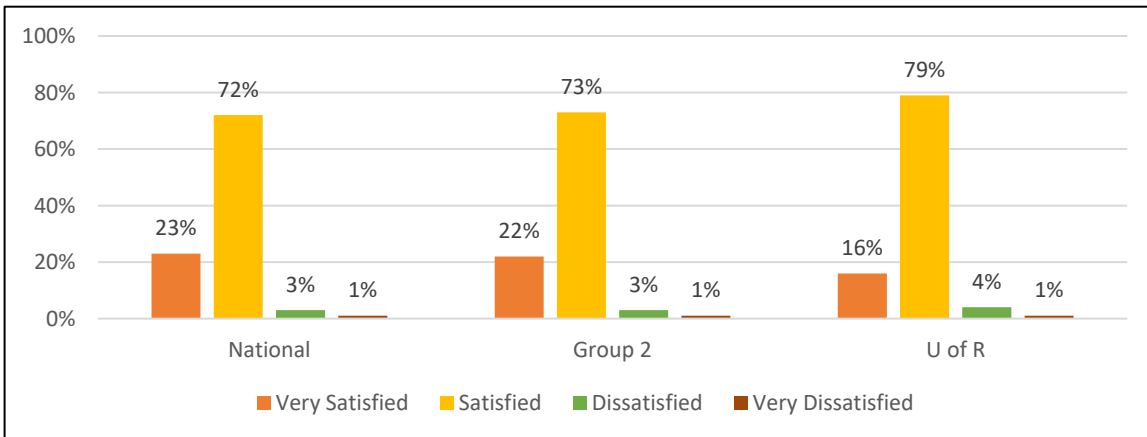


## Satisfaction with University's Efforts
