	means of transportation only and only used outdoors. No person shall	
	perform or engage in any acrobatics or other stunts with these items.

	Bicycle parking is permitted only in areas specifically designated by a bicycle	
	parking rack/stand or a secure bicycle cage. Bicycles cannot be affixed to	
	trees, rails, sign posts, or other objects not designed for the sole purpose of securing and storing bicycles.

-1.5	Bicycles operated on sidewalks shall yield the right of way to all pedestrians.	30.00

	No operator of a motor vehicle shall drive through or enter upon any road,

	indicated by any device, or sign as being closed or having restricted access.

	No operator shall travel on University property with dangerous goods in	
<b>F 2</b>	excess of the allowable quantity without written permission by the President.	50.00
5.3	Camping	50.00
	No person shall park and camp overnight on University property in either a motor vehicle, tent, or trailer without permission of the President.	
5.4	Obstructing Free Passage	60.00
5.4	No Person shall obstruct the free passage of traffic or any pedestrian walk or	00.00
	road without written permission of the President.	
5.5	Parades	60.00
	No Parades or processions shall be held on University property without the	
	permission of the President.	
5.6	Unauthorized Use of Electrical Outlet	100.00
	No operator shall plug a motor vehicle into an electrical outlet for which they	
	are not authorized to do so, or for which they have not paid the fee. Operators	
	shall not run an electrical cord into a non-electrified parking stall.

5.7	Repair Motor Vehicles – Repair/Service/Clean No operator shall wash, service, maintain, clean or repair a motor vehicle on	50.00
	campus except in the case of emergency repairs or where written permission has been obtain from the President.	
5.8	Uncoupled Trailers	50.00
	No person shall leave a trailer or tractor-trailer unattached to their motor	
	vehicle on any road, parking stall, bus stop, parking lot or any other place	
	unless permission has been obtained from the President.	
5.9	Engine Running	50.00
	No operator of a motor vehicle shall leave the engine running while loading or	
	unloading goods at any loading dock or any location prohibited by a sign.	
5.10	Interference with Parking Signage	50.00
	No person shall deface, alter, move, obstruct or interfere with any parking	
	signage on campus property.	
5.11	Tampering with Equipment	200.00
	No person shall deposit any substitute for coin or currency of Canada in a	
	parking meter or Paystation. No person shall deface, alter, damage, tamper with or impair any parking meter, pole, Paystation, permit card reader, permit	
	dispenser, parking lot gate, immobilizer, barricade, pylon or other equipment.

3.12	No person shall erect or maintain any traffic or parking warning or directional	50.00
	sign unless written permission has been obtained from the President.

	No person shall disobey any applicable instructions or directions indicated on

	No operator shall park a motor vehicle, or encroach in any way, on a space	
	identified as Accessible Parking Space or on an Accessible Ramp, unless it is

6.4.1	<b>Directional Parking – On Street/Loading Zone</b> Unless any on-street parking stall or loading zone is otherwise posted, no	50.00
	operator shall park a motor vehicle other than parallel with the curb, and with	
	the right hand wheels within thirty (30) centimetres of the curb, nor shall any	
	operator park, stand or stop a motor vehicle in any on-street parking stall or in	
	a loading zone so that any part of the vehicle projects into a road.	
6.4.2	Directional Parking – Parking Lot/ Pay Parking Zone	50.00
	Unless a parking stall within a parking lot or pay parking zone is otherwise	
	marked (or designated for angled parking), all operators must park a motor	
	vehicle ninety (90) degrees to the curb or parking rail, and with the front	
	bumper no less than thirty (30) centimetres from the curb or parking rail.	
6.4.3	Directional Parking – LPR Parking Lot	50.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle in any LPR parking lot other than facing	
	forward unless displaying a licence plate on the front of the vehicle.

	is not distinctly visible and legible from the diving lane or road.	
6.4.5	Directional Parking – Backing Into Parking Stall	50.00
	No operator shall back a motor vehicle into a parking stall unless the vehicle	
	displays a front licence plate that is clearly visible from the diving lane.	
6.4.6	Directional Parking – Left Hand Side to Curb	50.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle with the motor vehicle's left hand side	
	to the curb unless allows by signs in the case of one direction traffic.	
6.5.1	Time Limited Parking	50.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle beyond the time limit specified (i) by	
	the parking signage, (ii) the time limit specified on the ePermit for the	
	location, or (iii) the parking privileges paid for and obtained for the location.	
6.5.2	Exceeding Daily Time Limit	50.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle in any time-limited Pay Parking Zone	
	for more than the daily time-limit as indicated by parking signage.	
6.5.3	Meter Violation	50.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle in a Pay Parking Stall if the meter timer	
	indicates "Violation", "Time Expired", "Out of Order", "Fail" or "00.00", and if	
	said motor vehicle does not otherwise have a valid ePermit for such location.	
6.6	Double Parking	50.00
	No operator shall park their motor vehicle alongside one that is already	
67	parked at the side of the road for any purpose including loading/unloading.	50.00
6.7	No Stopping on Campus Roads	50.00
	No operator shall stop a motor vehicle on any road, except (i) when necessary	
	to avoid collision or conflict with other traffic; or (ii) in compliance with the directions of a Parking Enforcement Officer, Peace Officer or traffic signs.	
6.8.1	Non-Designated Area	50.00
0.0.1	No operator shall park any motor vehicles in areas not designated for parking	30.00
	(such as, but not limited to, landscaped areas, undeveloped areas, roads, and	
	sidewalks) without the written permission of the President.	
6.8.2	Reserved Parking Lot/Stall	100.00
0.0.2	No operator shall park a motor vehicle in a parking stall, Pay Parking Zone, or	100.00
	parking lot unless permitted for the privilege during the reserved period as	
	indicated by parking signage.	
6.8.3	Bus Stop	100.00
	No operator shall park, stand, or stop any motor vehicle in a bus stop. These	
	areas are explicitly for bus use and the loading and unloading of passengers.	
6.8.4	Fire Hydrant	100.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle within three (3) metres of a fire	
	hydrant except for the purpose of loading or unloading, providing the	
	operator remains at the wheel at all times ready to move when required.	
6.8.5	Obstruct Pedestrian Crossing	100.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle so as to obstruct a pedestrian crossing.	
6.8.6	Encroach Adjacent Stall	50.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle and encroach on adjacent parking stalls	
	and must remain in the boundaries indicated by lines, poles, etc.

6.8.7	Service Area – No ePermit or Parking Privilege	100.00
	Except in the case of a service vehicle, no operator shall park a motor vehicle	
	in a Service Stall or Service Area, or on a Service Road.	
6.8.8	Service Area – Time Limit Exceeded	50.00
	The operator or a service vehicle may only park in a Service Area during such a	
	time as the operator requires immediate access to their equipment. Service	
	vehicles can only park for the posted Service Area time limit.	
6.8.9	Stall Occupied	50.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle in a parking stall if the stall is already	
	occupied by another vehicle.	
6.8.10	Unlicenced Motor Vehicle	50.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle or trailer on University property unless	
	it is a registered motor vehicle and is displaying a valid licence plate.	
6.8.11	Propane Motor Vehicle	50.00
	No operator shall park a propane-fueled motor vehicle within an indoor	
	enclosed parkade or indoor loading dock.	
6.8.12	Blocked Parking Stalls	100.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle in a Blocked Parking Stall unless the	
	motor vehicle has been issued a valid ePermit with privileges for that location.	
6.8.13	Fire Lane	100.00
	No operator shall park a motor vehicle anywhere designated a Fire Lane, nor	
	the entrance and exit of a parking lot or any access lane within a parking area.	
6.9	Opening of Doors	50.00
	No person shall open a door of a motor vehicle on the side exposed to moving	
	traffic unless it is reasonably safe to do so, nor shall any person leave a door of	
	a motor vehicle open on the side exposed to moving traffic for a period of	
	time longer than necessary to load and unload passengers.	
6.10	Abandoned Vehicles	50.00
	No person shall park a motor vehicle in any location for longer than 72 hours	
6.11	unless permission has been obtained from the President. Motorcycles and Motorized Scooters	50.00
0.11	Motorcycles and motorized scooters are motor vehicles and must be parked in	50.00
	a parking lot or parking stall, or area designated for the parking of motorcycles	
	and motorized scooters.	
7.4.2	Failure to Stop/Pay	200.00
,	During the hours of operation, on entry to a controlled Pay Parking Lot, the	200.00
	operator is required to stop and obtain a permit from the automated ticket	
	dispenser. On exiting the controlled Pay Parking Lot, the operator is required	
	to stop and pay the fee required at the Paystation. Failure to stop and pay the	
	fee is a violation of these bylaws and the assessed fine is in addition to	
	accumulated parking charges to be paid.	
7.4.3	Share Permit or FOB/Aid Vehicle	200.00
	No person shall share or allow their authorized permit or FOB to be used in	
	aiding a second, previous or subsequent motor vehicle(s) from exiting or	
	attempting to exit a controlled parkade without paying.	
7.4.4	No Tailgating	100.00
	No operator of a motor vehicle shall exit a Controlled Pay Parking Lot before	
	allowing the gate to fully close after the previous motor vehicle.

7.5	Additional Penalties Any operator of an Unlawfully Parked Motor Vehicle is subject to receive an additional citation if the motor vehicle remains Unlawfully Parked after two (2) hours from the time the previous citation was issued.	50.00
7.6.2	Affixing of Permit If a physical permit is issued to an individual, the permit shall be affixed or so attached to the motor vehicle according to the instructions print on or provided with the permit.	50.00
7.6.3	<b>Removal of Permit</b> All permits which are no longer valid shall be removed from the motor vehicle.	50.00
9.2.6	Interference with Removal or Immobilization No person shall attempt to prevent the immobilization or removal of any motor vehicle or in any manner interfere with the immobilization or removal of any motor vehicle.	60.00
