**Welcome Back to Campus!** Welcome to the Fall 2023 academic term and for those who were working/ studying remotely, welcome back to campus! It is exciting to see new and familiar faces back on campus as we begin the fall semester. **All Parking is Paid Parking** When parked on Main Campus or College Avenue Campus, remember that a valid parking ePermit is required – no matter the length of time you plan on being here. Fall (Fall/Winter) parking ePermits are available for purchase on-line at <https://uregina.aimsparking.com/>! If you visit campus frequently, an ePermit will be your most cost-effective option.

**Parking Enforcement Times** Parking is enforced in all surface areas Monday – Friday, 8:00 am – 5:00 pm; Surface area parking is free after 5:00 pm (Monday-Friday) and on weekends and statutory holidays. Accessible stalls & time-limited parking areas are enforced 24/7. Parkades are enforced at all times

**Hiring a New Employee?** Help us to welcome them to campus! Parking will be the first point of contact for all new employees on campus – be sure your new hires are prepared to successfully park on their first day. Once an employee has been appointed with a UR ID number they are eligible to purchase a parking ePermit in advance of their first day of work. All new employees should be advised to visit the Parking and Transportation Services website to learn about parking on campus and directed to purchase the ePermit best fitting their needs.

**Appealing a Citation** All appeals must be submitted online within the first 7 days of the citation being issued. It is recommended that you review our information on the citation prior to the appeal. This may be done by following this link <https://uregina.aimsparking.com/tickets/> then entering your license plate & citation number and then viewing the photos below.

**License Plate Must Be Visible to Driving Lane (Bylaw 6.4.4)** In addition to the requirements set out in section 6.4.3, no Operator shall park a Motor Vehicle in any LPR Parking Lot other than facing forward unless the Motor Vehicle displays a license plate on the front of the vehicle.

**Ensuring that you are parked in the area designated for your ePermit** With the start of a new semester please ensure that you are parking in the area designated by your parking ePermit. It is good practice to brush up on the parking zones each semester by visiting <https://www.uregina.ca/parking/maps.html> and reviewing the applicable maps.

**“Reduced Citation Amount” Pay your Parking Citations within 14 calendar days**

The majority of parking citations offer an early discounted payment option ranging from 35% to 40% if paid within the first 14 Calendar days. To see if your citation is eligible please see the bottom front of your citation. Please note that if you have entered an appeal the 14-day time line will be paused and then resume once an appeal decision is made.

**The Parking and Transportation Services Facilities Maintenance Team**

This team is having the parking lots swept, repaired and graded, for the comfort of our ePermit Holders and Visitors.

Parkades are being swept and cleaned, and most of the jobs are being done after office hours, as we do not want to disturb our Visitors or ePermit Holders who park there.

**Hosting Visitors or Events on Campus?**

Parking arrangements MUST be made well in advance of guest arrivals to ensure a positive parking experience. Parking and Transportation Services can offer your department a variety of options for setting up your campus guests with parking ePermits. *Did you know...*

Contactless ePermit holder parking in KHS Parkade: There is no need to open your windows, especially at -40 degrees Celsius, the cameras read the permit holder's license plate and trigger the parkade vehicle doors.

Accessible parking stalls are also signed with Blue bollards. They are reserved 24/7.
