Re: Verbal response to External Review

Dear Dr. Cule,

Thank you for meeting with CCAM colleagues on December 5th to discuss the External Reviewers' Report and provide us with your preliminary response. Your comments to the committee regarding the review was very helpful, and it is our hope the resulting discussion will be useful as you craft your written response to what we felt was a very positive report.

The next step of the process is for the Department to prepare a written response to CCAM and the Provost's Office. We ask for the following considerations in the preparation of your response.

- Please comment on *each* of the external reviewer recommendations. This should highlight on any of the report recommendations your unit disagrees with and the rationale for the same. Please also include a work plan outlining the actions your unit will take to implement the report's findings.
- 2) Please place these comment and subsequent work plan within the context of the areas of focus as noted in the Academic Unit Review Operations Manual (OPS-130-005) and University's broad goals of student success, research impact, and commitment to community within the overarching themes of Indigenization and Sustainability.
- 3) CCAM recognizes that the external reviewers had recommendations for the Economics Department which the Department either feels are not appropriate to pursue right now or which are properly decisions of the Faculty of Arts. We'd ask, though, that the Department continue to reflect on all recommendations of the external review and to track its status in regard to them through the rest of the review cycle.

4) Though Indigenization was touched on only briefly touched on in our discussion it is are a strategic priorities for the University. CCAM would ask that the Department continue to give both priorities its careful attention as it moves forward.

The committee looks forward to meeting with the unit again in 15 – 18 months to discuss the health of the unit. In advance of the 15-18 month meeting, please provide written documentation to CCAM, and/or your Unit's work plan, outlining your progress on each of the reviewer's recommendations.

In five-years' time it is anticipated that the unit will submit a final update to CCAM demonstrating the achievements of the unit as a result of the Academic Unit Review process.
