I wish to provide our CCAM colleagues with an update on the Faculty of Nursing's processes regarding Accreditation (through the Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing [CASN]) and Program Approval (through the College of Registered Nurses of Saskatchewan [CRNS]). This update will include updates to our undergraduate and graduate programming.

CASN Accreditation

a. Undergraduate Programming:

The CASN self-study documents were shared with CCAM in February 2023. On June 2, 2023, the collaborative undergraduate programs (Saskatchewan Collaborative Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program, After Degree Nursing Program, and Practical Nurse to BScN pathway) received seven (7) year accreditation with recommendations and the provision of an interim report from the Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing. Seven years is the maximum term accreditation can be awarded. We are so incredibly proud of our students, staff, and faculty.

The additional information/recommended actions to be addressed in the interim reports and the timelines for submission are as follows. We will submit these items to CASN per their requested schedule.

August 12, 2020, the collaborative graduate program (Collaborative Nurse Practitioner Program) received seven (7) year accreditation with recommendations and the provision of an interim report from the Canadian Association of Schools of Nursing.
