

FACULTY OF ARTS (HUMANITIES)

In accordance with the Council Rules and Regulations, persons with the following ranks are eligible for nomination and election to Executive of Council: Professor, Associate Professor, Assistant Professor, Lecturer, Special Lecturer, Instructor (including Lab and Clinical), and Professional Librarians, whose appointments fall into one of the following categories (a) continuing; (b) full-time probationary or term.

The term of office for members of Executive of Council is two years. Terms will run from July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2026.

The Faculty of Arts (Humanities) electoral unit is entitled to 6 representatives. THREE (3) representatives are required for the term of July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2026.
