May 21 by 8:00 a.m. CST	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deadline to submit an application for institutional endorsement to amy.hunter@uregina.ca. Applications must include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Resume/CV; ○ A personal statement of 750 words outlining <i>who you are</i>. This is a personal statement, so be authentic and tell the committee why they should pick you! ○ An academic statement of 350 words. Include the reasons <i>why</i> you want to go to Oxford and <i>which</i> academic program at Oxford you will choose ; ○ A list of the following for at least six potential referees*: name; email; indication if they are an academic or character reference; a few sentences for each referee, indicating your relationship to them and what elements of your application they are best positioned to speak to. A good referee is one who knows you well, rather than a well-known person who only knows you superficially.
June 4 & 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Selected applicants will meet with University of Regina External Student Awards Committee to be considered for institutional endorsement.
June-September	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Endorsed applicants to finalize application documents (see #5 of the Rhodes – Canada Information for Candidates document) and confirm referee participation.
September 2024	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deadline for endorsed applicants to apply to Rhodes Trust
Early October	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deadline for reference & endorsement letters to be submitted.
Variable (soon after selection by the Rhodes Committee)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If selected, students must apply to Oxford University program of choice by the specified deadline (see #7 of the Rhodes – Canada Information for Candidates document)

* Reference letters are not required for the application for institutional endorsement though possible references can be made aware that, if you are shortlisted as a U of R endorsed applicant, they will have until October to complete and submit their assessment.

** All candidates enrolled at the University of Regina must submit an **application for institutional endorsement** to amy.hunter@uregina.ca (due May 21) and participate in the internal competition/applicant meeting adjudicated by the External Student Awards Committee. Endorsed candidates will be contacted regarding completing the online Rhodes Trust application. The online application process requires endorsement only available through the External Student Award Committee.*
