# Portfolio of projects

- Inventory of research infrastructure
- Amendment requests that benefit a portfolio of projects
- Single procurements to address multiple infrastructure needs
- Managing CFI-funded infrastructure as core facilities

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# Core facilities

- Increased utilization and broader access
- Avoid duplication
- Economies of scale
- Skilled operators
- Promotion of inter-disciplinarity
- Attraction of external users
- Improved sustainability

# Proposal development and internal review process

- Personnel involved at the proposal stage: research services, finance, procurement, and facilities management
- Internal review process: internal and external membership
- Suggested reviewers: cannot be included in principal users, other users or collaborate on project

# Timely implementation

- Giving consideration to all key aspects of a project's implementation at the proposal development stage
- Establishing realistic and reasonable implementation timelines at the proposal and award finalization stages
- Finalizing award agreements quickly
- Monitoring project timelines during implementation

# Operation & maintenance

- Developing appropriate project-specific management and sustainability plans at the proposal development stage
- Long-term planning and monitoring of O&M costs and related funding
- Adopting strategies that optimize resources for the O&M of the institution's portfolio of projects (e.g. making optimal use of the Infrastructure Operating Fund, locating infrastructure in core facilities where shared technicians can maintain infrastructure related to several projects)

# Project leader moving to another institution

- JELF award
  - Not finalized: may be transferred to another Canadian institution, if not will be withdrawn
  - Finalized: institution keep equipment and name another project leader OR transfer award to another Canadian institution, if not award will be withdrawn and reimbursed
- Innovation Fund award
  - Institution(s) keep equipment and name another project leader

# Advanced research computing

- Capacity or throughput computing
- Capability computing supporting tightly coupled, fine-grained applications
- Shared memory systems
- Systems supporting very large memory requirements
- High-performance storage
- Long-term storage
- Cloud computing
- Computing using specialized accelerators, including GP-CPU and others
- High-performance visualization systems
- Systems suitable for computational steering and interactive use
  
- When to talk to Compute Canada? **Always**

# In-kind contributions

## Establishing fair market value

- Confirmation from supplier of price after normal and educational discounts
- Other bids that provide useful market comparisons
- Cash paid in a previous purchase of similar item (not related to a CFI-funded project)
- Experience with supplier's discount structure

## In-kind contribution in excess of \$500,000

- Price must be corroborated with other sources of information
- Fair market value must be formally assessed by performing:
  - a market comparison
  - a comparison with previous purchases at the institution or by other institutions
  - an appraisal

- Strategic tool

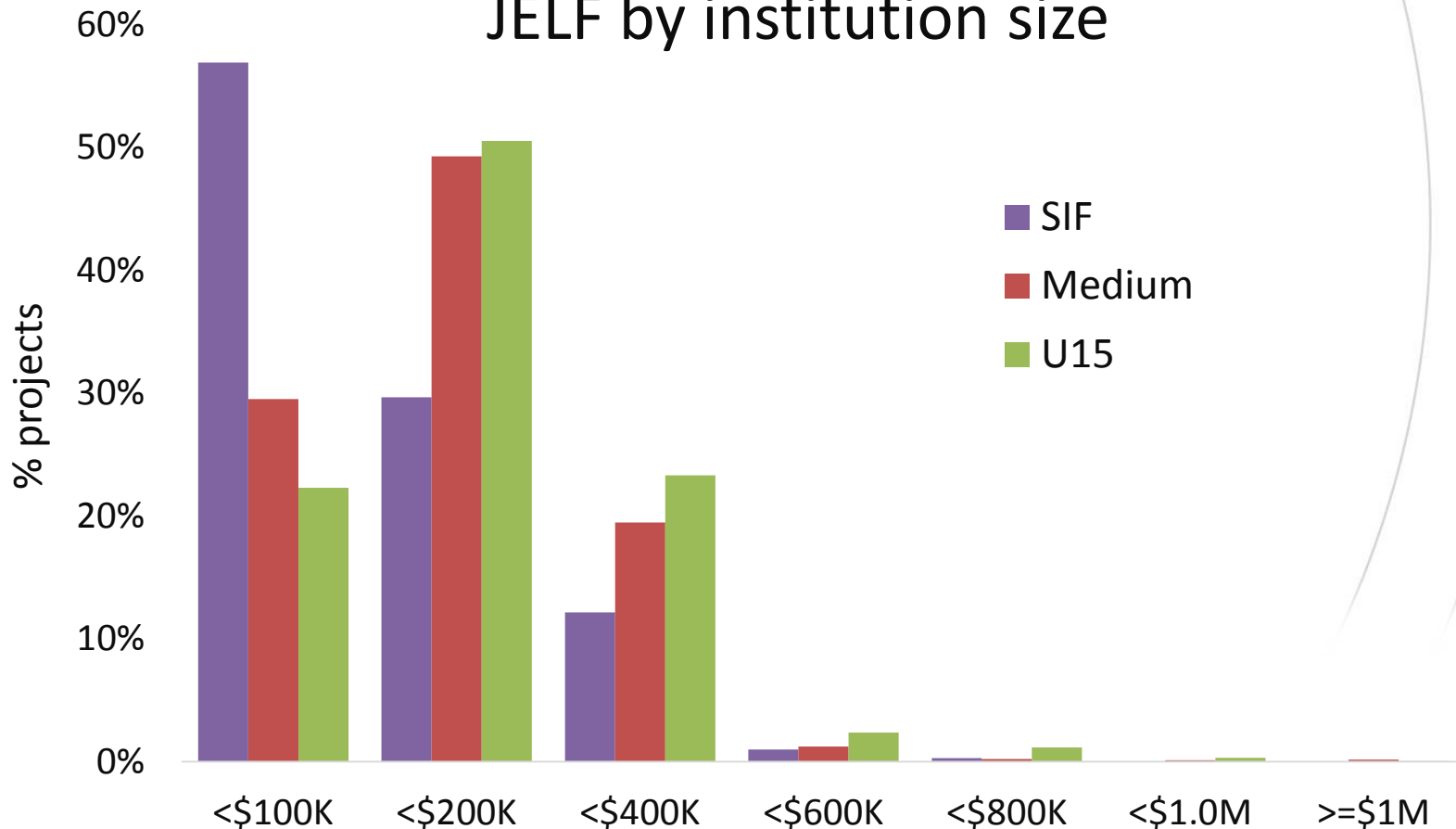
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# Historical data

# Application size

- One document - 17 pages  (6 p. reduction)
- Modify *Need for infrastructure* criterion
- Revisit wording of the assessment criterion and instructions

# Strategic Research Plans

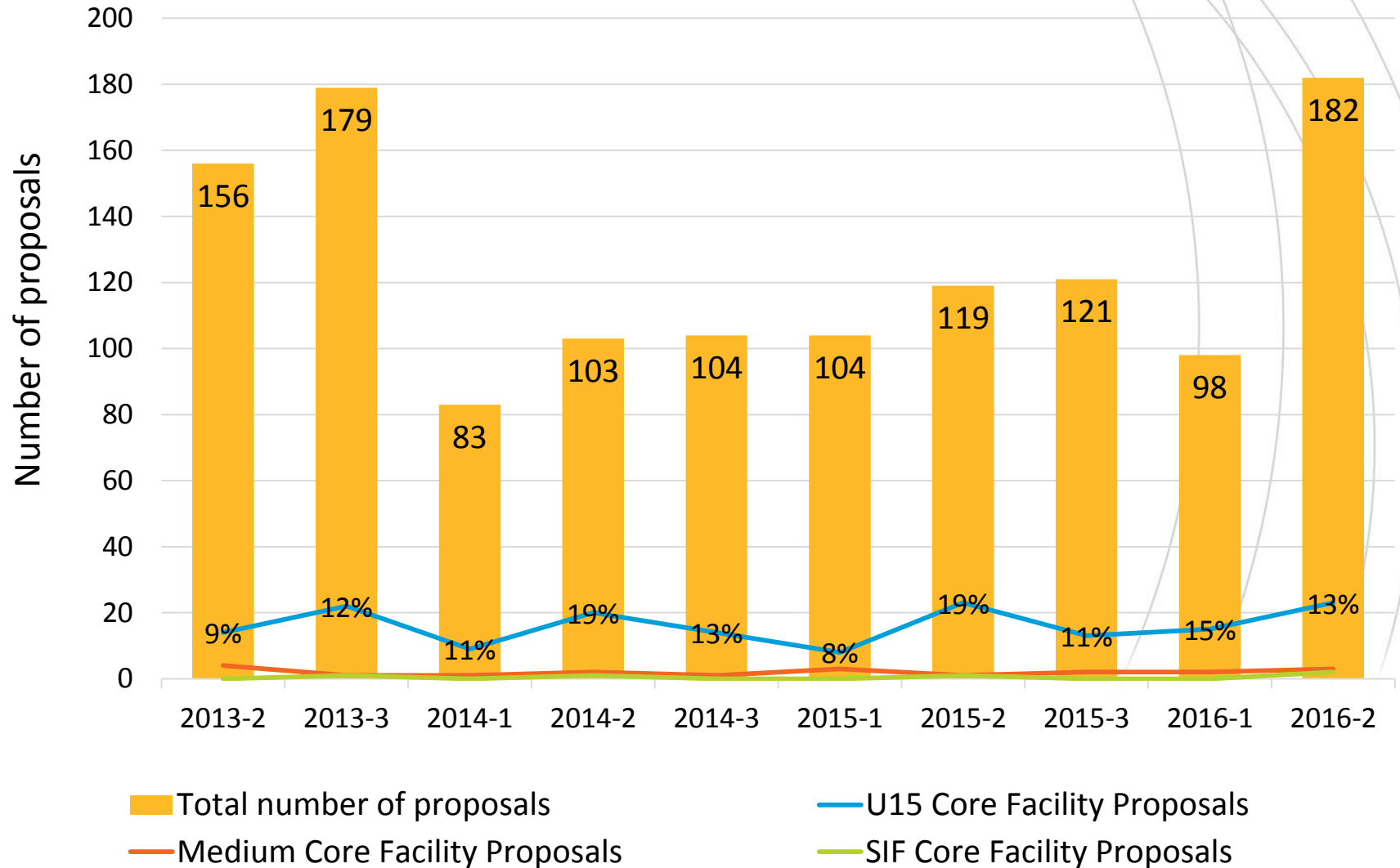
- No longer provide link to SRP to reviewers
- Proposal submission letter
- Institutional commitment and sustainability

# “Workhorse” infrastructure

- Revisit wording to increase clarity in guidelines and instructions
- Build and enhance research capacity
- Add drop list or tick box

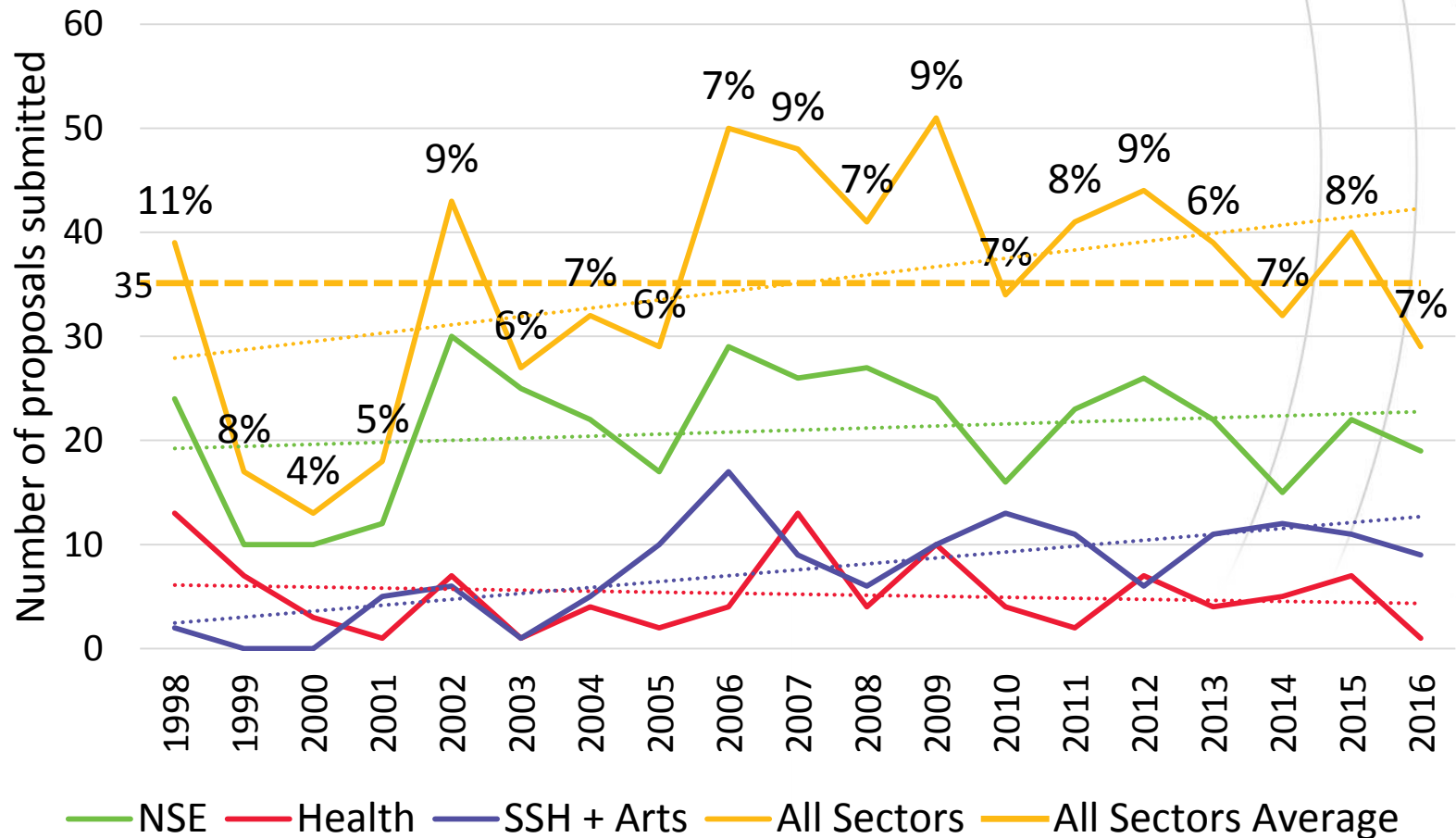


# Proposals with infrastructure being placed in a core facility (submissions per JELF round)
