NEW DATASETS IN THE RDC

CANADIAN COMMUNITY HEALTH SURVEY (CCHS) 2022

The **Canadian Community Health Survey (CCHS)** gathers health-related data at the sub-provincial levels of geography (health region or combined health regions).

CANADIAN COMMUNITY HEALTH SURVEY (CCHS) RAPID RESPONSE - WORK PRODUCTIVITY AND WORK FAMILY BALANCE *New!*

The **Canadian Community Health Survey - Rapid Response - Work productivity and Work family balance (CCHS RR WPL WLB)** is part of the rapid response component of the CCHS. It contains data collected from July to December 2022, with content on work-family balance (WLB) and on work productivity (WPL).

CANADIAN SOCIAL SURVEY - QUALITY OF LIFE AND ENERGY USE *New!*

The **Canadian Social Survey - Quality of life and energy use (CSS-QLEU)** collect information from individuals and families on quality of life, energy use and household energy expenditures.

CANADIAN SOCIAL SURVEY - QUALITY OF LIFE, VIRTUAL HEALTH CARE AND TRUST *New!*

The **Canadian Social Survey - Quality of Life, Virtual Health Care and Trust (CSS-QLVHCT)** collects information from individuals and families on quality of life, virtual health care and trust.

CANADIAN SURVEY ON EARLY LEARNING AND CHILD CARE (CSELCC) 2023 *New!*

The **Canadian Survey on Early Learning and Child Care (CSELCC)** gathers information from parents and guardians on early learning and child care arrangements for children aged 0 to 5.

CANADIAN VITAL STATISTICS BIRTH DATABASE (CVSB) 2022

The **Canadian Vital Statistics - Birth database (CVSB)** is an administrative survey that collects demographic information annually from all provincial and territorial vital statistics registries on all live births in Canada.

NEW DATASETS IN THE RDC

CANADIAN VITAL STATISTICS DEATH DATABASE (CVSD) 2021

The **Canadian Vital Statistics - Death Database** ([CVSD](#)) is an administrative survey that collects demographic and medical (cause of death) information annually and monthly from all provincial and territorial vital statistics registries on all deaths in Canada.

LONGITUDINAL ADMINISTRATIVE DATABANK (LAD) 2021

The **Longitudinal Administrative Databank** ([LAD](#)) now spans 40 years, from 1982 to 2021, and contains information about individuals and their census families. The LAD consists of a 20% longitudinal sample of Canadian tax filers and provides researchers and analysts with a tool for studying the changes in income of individuals and their families.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE IN DYING 2022

The **Medical Assistance in Dying** ([MAID](#)) is based on reports from physicians and nurse practitioners on written requests for and provisions of Medical Assistance in Dying (MAID) across Canada for the 2019, 2020 and 2021 calendar years.

PUBLIC SECTOR SURVEY ON CYBER SECURITY AND CYBERCRIME 2022 *New!*

The **Public Sector Survey on Cyber Security and Cybercrime** ([PSSCSC](#)) provide insights on the impact of cybercrime on the Canadian public service and crown corporations, including the investment in cyber security measures, cyber security training, the volume of cyber security incidents and the costs associated with responding to these incidents.

SURVEY ON EARLY LEARNING AND CHILD CARE ARRANGEMENT 2023

The **Survey on Early Learning and Child Care Arrangements** ([SELCCA](#)) gathers information from parents and guardians on early learning and child care arrangements for children under the age of 6 in the 3 territories of Canada.

SURVEY ON ACCESSIBLE PRINT MATERIALS (SAPM) 2023 *New!*

The **Survey on Accessible Print Materials** ([SAPM](#)) gathers information from Canadians who require printed works in alternate formats.
