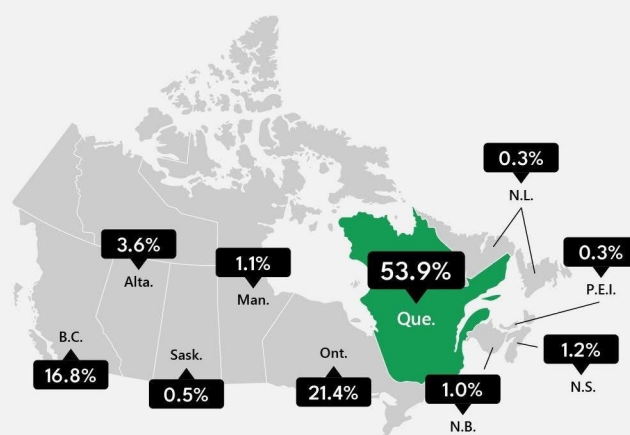

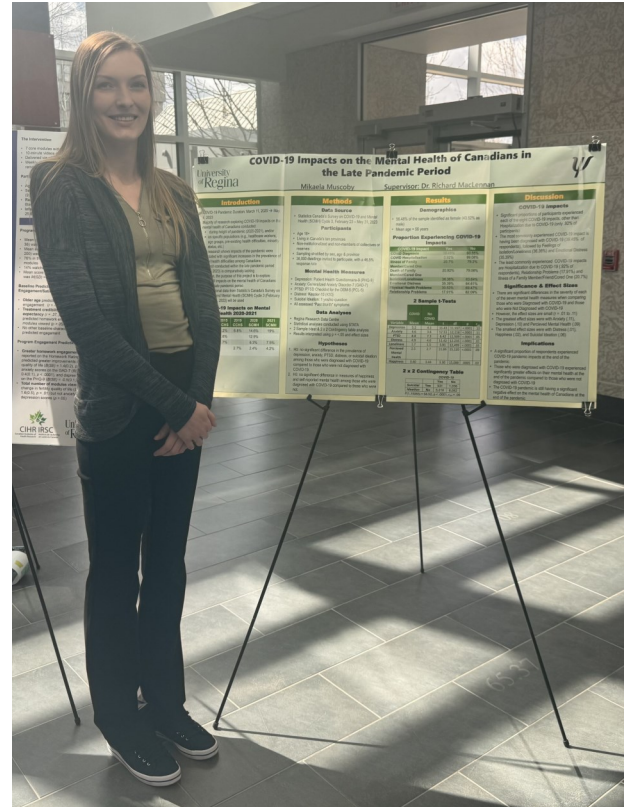

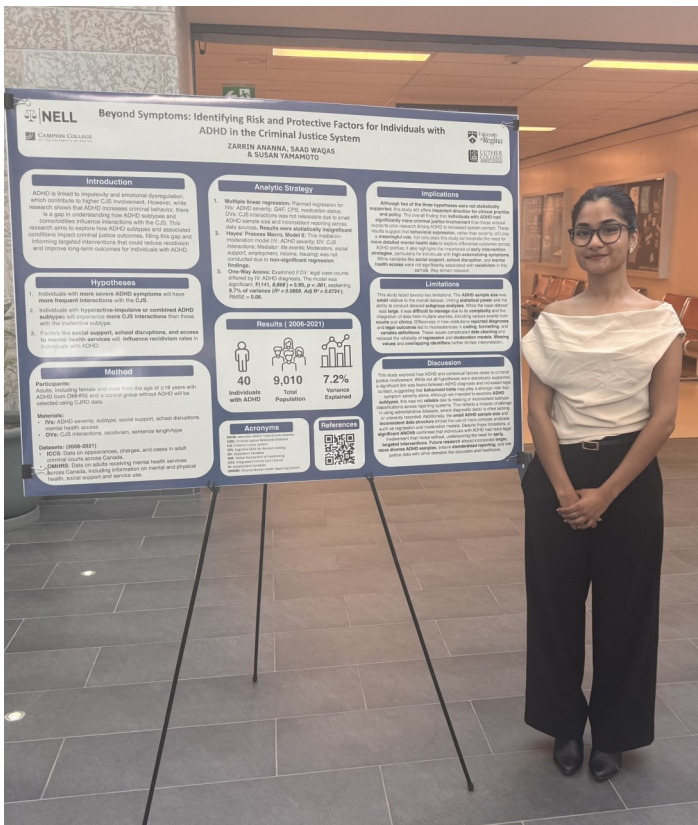

NEW DATASETS IN THE RDC

CANADIAN COMMUNITY HEALTH SURVEY 2023 - RAPID RESPONSE SMOKING - STAGES OF CHANGE 2 AND TOBACCO ALTERNATIVES PRODUCTS

The **Canadian Community Health Survey (CCHS) 2023 - Rapid Response Smoking - stages of change 2 (SCH2) and Tobacco alternatives products (TAL)** is part of the rapid response component of the Canadian Community Health Survey. It contains data collected from January to December 2023, with content on smoking - stages of change and tobacco alternatives.

CANADIAN COMMUNITY HEALTH SURVEY 2023 - WORK FAMILY BALANCE

The **Canadian Community Health Survey (CCHS) 2023 - Rapid Response Work family balance (WLB)** is part of the rapid response component of the Canadian Community Health Survey. It contains data collected from July to December 2023, with content on work-family balance (WLB).

CANADIAN CORONER AND MEDICAL EXAMINER DATABASE LINKED TO THE CANADIAN VITAL STATISTICS DEATHS *New!*

The **Canadian Coroner and Medical Examiner Database (CCMED)** facilitates the identification and characterization of emerging and known safety hazards with the aim of contributing to a decrease in preventable deaths among Canadians. The **Canadian Vital Statistics - Death database (CVSD)** is an administrative survey that collects demographic and medical (cause of death) information annually and monthly from all provincial and territorial vital statistics registries on all deaths in Canada.

CANADIAN ORAL HEALTH SURVEY 2023-2024 *New!*

The **Canadian Oral Health Survey (COHS)** gathers information on Canadians' oral health, including their ability to pay, challenges and experiences with the oral health care services, and care needs.

CANADIAN SURVEY ON BUSINESS CONDITIONS 2023 *New!*

The **Canadian Survey on Business Conditions (CSBC)** collects information on businesses in Canada related to emerging issues. This iteration of the survey focused on business expectations and business conditions in Canada.

CANADIAN VITAL STATISTICS DEATH DATABASE 2023

The **Canadian Vital Statistics - Death database (CVSD)** collects demographic and medical (cause of death) information annually and monthly from all provincial and territorial vital statistics registries on all deaths in Canada.



NEW DATASETS IN THE RDC

EMPLOYMENT INSURANCE COVERAGE SURVEY 2022 & 2023

The **Employment Insurance Coverage Survey** ([EICS](#)) provides a meaningful picture of who does or does not have access to EI benefits among the jobless and those in a situation of underemployment. The survey also covers access to maternity and parental benefits.

LONGITUDINAL ADMINISTRATIVE DATABANK 2000: SCHEDULE 3 (CAPITAL GAINS/LOSSES) *New!*

The **Longitudinal Administrative Databank** ([LAD](#)) is a longitudinal file designed as a research tool on income and demographics. The **LAD linked to T1FF Schedule 3 for Capital Gains/Losses for year 2000 (LAD-T1FF-S3-2000)** provides a more precise estimate of the total net capital gains and losses for the year 2000.

LONGITUDINAL IMMIGRATION DATABASE 2023

The **Longitudinal Immigration Database** ([IMDB](#)) provides detailed and reliable information on the performance and impact of immigration programs.

PROGRAMME FOR THE INTERNATIONAL ASSESSMENT OF ADULT COMPETENCIES 2022

The **Programme for the International Assessment of Adult Competencies** ([PIAAC](#)) is a multi-cycle international program and an initiative of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD). It aims to collect information on the competencies of adults from several countries, including Canada.

SURVEY ON SEXUAL MISCONDUCT IN THE CANADIAN ARMED FORCES 2022

The **Survey on Sexual Misconduct in the Canadian Armed Forces** ([SSMCAF](#)) collects information on experiences of sexual misconduct in the military workplace.

SURVEY OF ORAL HEALTH CARE PROVIDERS 2023 *New!*

The **Survey of Oral Health Care Providers** ([SOHCP](#)) helps assess the current state of the oral health care system in Canada while providing insight into the changes that could impact this sector, including implementation of the Canadian Dental Care Plan.

SURVEY SERIES ON FIRST NATIONS PEOPLE, MÉTIS, AND INUIT - HEALTH CARE ACCESS AND EXPERIENCE 2024 *New!*

The **Survey Series on First Nations People, Métis, and Inuit - Health Care Access and Experience** ([SSFNPMI-HCAE](#)) collects information on Indigenous peoples' experiences with health care, access to different types of health care, discrimination, and prescription medication.
