The **Annual Industrial Consumption of Energy Survey (ICE)** provides estimates of energy consumption by manufacturing establishments in Canada.

CANADIAN SOCIAL SURVEY - QUALITY OF LIFE, HEALTH AND HOUSING COSTS 2024 New!

The Canadian Social Survey - Quality of Life, Health and Housing Costs (CSS-QLHHC) collects information about quality of life, housing costs and health, including recent respiratory infections.

CANADIAN SOCIAL SURVEY - QUALITY OF LIFE, HEALTH AND IMPACTS OF RISING PRICES 2024 New!

The Canadian Social Survey - Quality of Life, Health and Impacts of Rising Prices (<u>CSS-QLHIRP</u>) collects information about quality of life, health and impacts of rising prices.

CANADIAN SURVEY OF CYBER SECURITY AND CYBERCRIME 2023

The Canadian Survey of Cyber Security and Cybercrime (CSCSC) measures the impact of cybercrime on Canadian businesses.

The **Households and the Environment Survey** (<u>HES</u>) provides context to scientific measures of air and water quality, and greenhouse gas emissions, by gaining a better understanding of household behaviour and practices with respect to the environment.

LONGITUDINAL ADMINISTRATIVE DATABANK 2022

The **Longitudinal Administrative Databank** (<u>LAD</u>) is a longitudinal file designed as a research tool on income and demographics.

SURVEY OF ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY 2007, 2014, 2022 New!

The Survey of Advanced Technology

(SAT) collects information about the extent to which Canadian enterprises use advanced technologies.

SURVEY OF DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY AND INTERNET USE 2023

The **Survey of Digital Technology and Internet Use** (<u>SDTIU</u>) measures the impact of digital technologies, including the Internet and specific information and communication technologies (ICTs), on the operations of Canadian enterprises.

SURVEY ON MENTAL HEALTH AND STRESSFUL EVENTS 2023

The **Survey on Mental Health and Stressful Events** (<u>SMHSE</u>) collects data from Canadians to better understand how stressful events can impact a person's mental health.
