
**CRDCN 2022 Data Forum** sessions now available on the CRDCN **Youtube page**.

# NEW DATASETS IN THE RDC

### CANADIAN SOCIAL SURVEY WAVE 1 - WELL-BEING, SHARED VALUES AND TRUST

The Canadian Social Survey Wave 1 - Well-being, shared values and trust (<u>CSS</u>) collects information about well-being, shared values, trust in people, and confidence in Canadian institutions.

### **CANADIAN SOCIAL SURVEY WAVE 2—WELL-BEING AND CAREGIVING**

The Canadian Social Survey Wave 2 - Well-being and caregiving (<u>CSS</u>) collects information about well-being, unpaid caregiving and paid care work.

#### CANADIAN SURVEY OF CYBER SECURITY AND CYBERCRIME

The Canadian Survey of Cyber Security and Cybercrime (CSCSC) collects information on The measures organizations have implemented for cyber security, including employee training, the types of cyber security incidents that impact organizations, and the costs associated with preventing and recovering from cyber security incidents

#### SURVEY ON BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE IN CANADA New!

The **Survey on Before and After School care in Canada** (SBASCC) collects data on the different types of learning and child care arrangements used by families, difficulties some families may face when looking for care, as well as reasons for not using child care.

#### SURVEY ON FINANCING AND GROWTH OF SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES New!

The **Survey on Financing and Growth of Small and medium Enterprises** (<u>SFGSME</u>) collects information on barriers to growth, the financial position of small and medium enterprises, the characteristics of ownership and the extent to which the enterprise is involved in innovation and intellectual property.
