



# **NEW DATASETS IN THE RDC**

#### **BUSINESS ECONOMIC ANALYSIS MICRODATA Coming Soon!**

The **Business Economic Analysis Microdata (BEAM)** files are an extraction of the Canadian Employer Employee Dynamics Database (<u>CEEDD</u>). This linkable employer-employee dataset is based on processed administrative data sources from Statistics Canada (StatCan), Canada Revenue Agency (CRA), Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC) and Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship Canada (IRCC).

#### CRIMINAL ORGANIZATION AND STREET GANG OFFENCES New!

The Criminal Organization and Street Gang Offences (COSGO) files identify a cohort of individuals that were involved in police-reported criminal organization/street gang offences between 2016 and 2021, as well as their involvement in previous and subsequent police-reported incidents. The files include data from the Uniform Crime Reporting Survey (UCR), the Integrated Criminal Courts Survey (ICCS), and the Integrated Correctional Services Survey (ICSS)/Canadian Correctional Services Survey (CCSS). These files are supplemented with the Canadian Index of Multiple Deprivation (CIMD).

#### SURVEY OF EMPLOYEES UNDER FEDERAL JURISDICTION New!

The **Survey of Employees under Federal Jurisdiction** (<u>SEFJ</u>) collects information from a sample of employees working for businesses under federal jurisdiction, including regular, seasonal, term, and casual or on-call employees.

#### **NURSING AND RESIDENTIAL CARE FACILITY SURVEY New!**

The **Nursing and Residential Care Facility Survey** (NRCFS) will be used to standardize national, provincial, and regional statistics on nursing and residential care facilities in Canada. This will allow governments and researchers to examine the correlation between facility operations and personnel, health outcomes of residents, and system-level performance during pandemics or other emergencies.
