

PRE-CHIROPRACTIC

Doctor of Chiropractic (DC). The program is four years in length and requires that a student complete a minimum of three years (90 credit hours) of undergraduate university study prior to admission to the Chiropractic program. Applicants should request admission to the Faculty of Arts, the Faculty of Kinesiology and Health Studies, or the Faculty of Science.

Course Recommendations

Pre-Chiropractic:

1. BIOL 100
2. BIOL 101
3. CHEM 104
4. CHEM 140
5. CHEM 241
6. PSYC 101 or 102
7. 3 courses from the Faculty of Arts (humanities and/or social sciences)
8. 63.0 credit hours towards a bachelor's degree

** CHEM 104 – requires CHEM 30 (at least 65%), or CHEM 100 (minimum 65%).

Students must complete at least three full years (90 credit hours) of university study in any discipline. There are NO specific required courses. However, it is recommended that applicants complete one full course with a lab in organic chemistry and biology, an introductory psychology course and at least three courses in the humanities and/or social sciences.

About the Doctor of Chiropractic, Canadian Memorial Chiropractic College:

Doctor of Chiropractic (DC). The program is four years in length and requires that a student complete a minimum of three years (90 credit hours) of undergraduate university study prior to admission to the Chiropractic program. Applicants should request admission to the Faculty of Arts, the Faculty of Kinesiology and Health Studies, or the Faculty of Science.

Required Grades and Averages: (following completion of at least three full years (90 credit hours) of university study)

The minimum required in order to be considered for admission is an undergraduate CGPA of 2.50 on a 4.00 scale (approx. 70%)

Other Admission Requirements & Selection Criteria:

The admission evaluation is derived from an academic assessment and interview. All information resulting from the admission process is considered by the Admissions Committee in making its final selection. For more information, consult CMCC's web site.

Applications must be received by CMCC by October 31 for entry the following August.
