



## UR Learner Pathway and Transfer Opportunities

### Advanced Placement (AP)

AP is an internationally recognized program that prepares students to experience college or university-level courses while enrolled in high school. **The University of Regina recognizes AP exams achieved with grades of 4 or better for transfer credit.** Students must request an official transcript from the College Board to be sent to the University of Regina for transfer credit consideration.
