Advanced Placement (AP)

AP is an internationally recognized program that prepares students to experience college or university-level courses while enrolled in high school. The University of Regina recognizes the following AP exams for transfer credit. Students must request an official transcript from the College Board to be sent to the University of Regina for transfer credit consideration.
