With so many academic and administrative functions now taking place remotely to protect our campus community, further changes to food services are being implemented. **As of Friday, March 27 at 5 p.m., all University of Regina Food Services (Chartwells) will be closed** until further notice. Food service will still be available on campus for students living in residence who have meal plans.

Luther College Cafeteria will be open to residents:

- Monday-Friday: 10 am to 6 pm
- Saturday and Sunday: 12 pm to 6 pm
- A set take-out menu only will be available.
- Chartwells-issued dining cards will be accepted at Luther College Cafeteria until the end of the Winter 2020 semester on April 24.
- Students will be asked to provide student ID as proof of identity. No members of the public will be served.
