

Subject: Annual Report from the Council Discipline Committee

Background and Description:



Per the section titled "Student Code of Conduct and Right to Appeal" in the Undergraduate Calendar, the Council Discipline Committee (CDC) hears appeals of decisions concerning academic and non-academic misconduct. CDC has the authority to uphold the original finding, overturn it, and/or adjust the penalty (increase or decrease).

During the 2023-2024 academic year (to June 30, 2024), the CDC will have considered twenty-four (24) appeals

and one (1) petition to attend the University of Regina. There are twenty-four (24) appeals pending, to be heard in the Spring/Summer and Fall 2024 terms. Of the twenty four (24) appeals to be scheduled, eleven (11) involve repeat offenses. In comparison, in 2023 there were nine (9) outstanding appeals.

This has resulted in differing penalty outcomes for appeals that were related to pre-Fall 2023 findings, in comparison to findings from academic misconduct investigations starting in September 2023.
